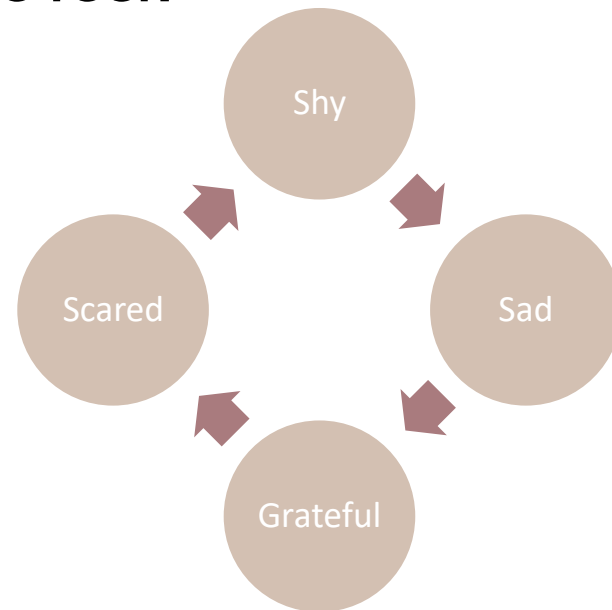

O Allah, help me to remember You, be grateful to You and worship You in an excellent manner (Abū Dāwūd).

قَدِيرٌ ، اللَّهُمَّ لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا أَعْطَيْتَ ، وَلَا مُعْطِيَ لِمَا مَنَعْتَ ، وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا
الْجُدِّ مِنْكَ الْجُدُّ .

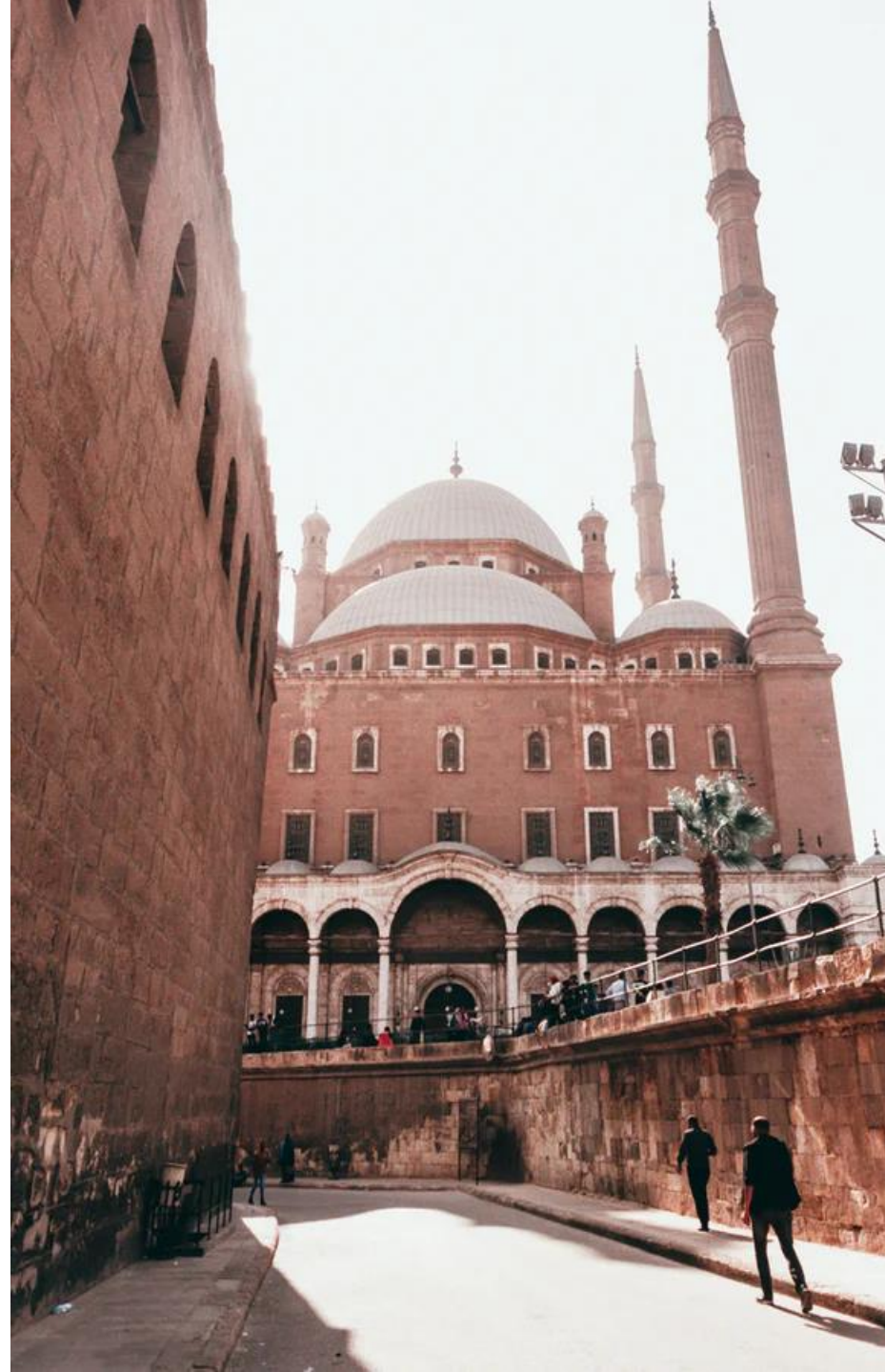
