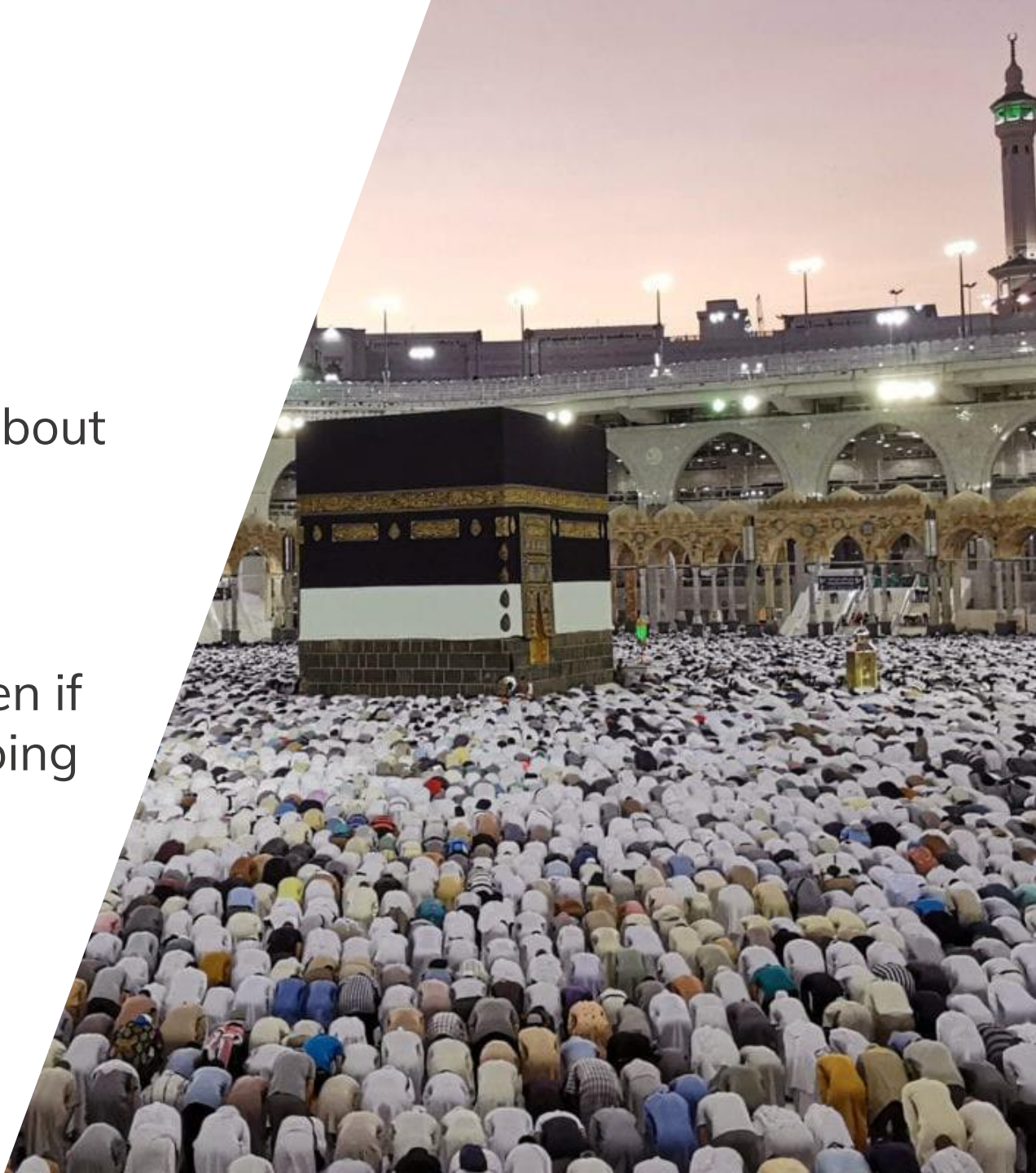
A Season of Mercy



You may already know that Dhul Hijjah is the month where millions of Muslims make a very special journey to....?

...Hajj!

- What do you already know about Hajj?
- Is Dhul Hijjah a special time even if you are NOT going on Hajj?
- Yes!



Virtues of Dhul Hijjah

وَالْفَجْرِ ﴿١﴾ وَلَيَالٍ عَشْرٍ ﴿٢﴾

“By the daybreak, and by 10 Nights” (89:1-2).

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said,

“There are no better days in the sight of Allah than the 10 days of Dhul Hijjah”.

(Ibn Hibbān)

Critical Question

Q. Does that mean the Days of Dhul Hijjah are better than the days of Ramadan?

Answer: The days of the first 10 days of Dhul Hijjah are superior to the last 10 days of Ramadan.

However, the nights of Ramadan are superior to the nights of Dhul Hijjah. There is a night in Ramadan which is superior to all other nights...do you know the name of that night?

Answer: Laylat al-Qadr.

Day of Arafah (9th Dhul Hijjah)

“There is no day wherein Allah sets free more slaves from Hell-fire than the day of ‘Arafah. Indeed, He draws near, and He then boasts about them to the angels and says: ‘What do these (slaves of mine) want?’” (Muslim).

This means it's a very IMPORTANT time of year to make dua and do dhikr!

Day No. 9 (Day of 'Arafah)

- Keep a fast.
- Takbir of Tashriq once after each fard salah, starting from Fajr.
- Lots of dhikr; and repeat frequently:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ، وَلَهُ
الْحَمْدُ، وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

- Du'a, especially for freedom from Hell.

Q. What are some Sunnahs of Eid al-Adha?

Pray in an open space, outdoors.

All women should attend.

Walk to the Eid Salah.

Take a different route when going and coming back from Salah.

Say the Eid Takbirat Loudly.

Congratulate all Muslims, by saying the following phrase:

تقبل الله منا ومنكم

○ What Does الله أكبر (Takbir) Mean?

○ الله أكبر means 'Allah is Greater than...' By not specifying what He is Greater than, we are saying that He is Greater than everything. Allah is Greater than anything we can imagine, and His greatness encompasses all things:

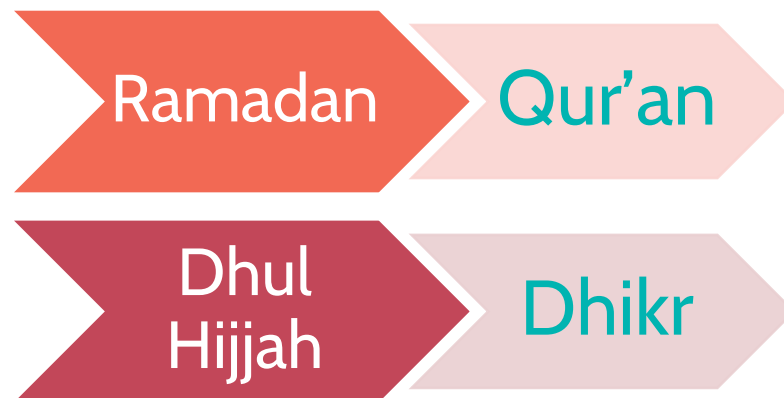

Dhikr



The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: “There are no days greater in the sight of Allah or in which good deeds are more beloved to Him than these 10 days. So recite a great deal of **tahlīl**, **takbīr** and **taḥmīd**.” (Aḥmad)

Fasting



“The Messenger of Allah ﷺ used to fast on the first nine days of Dhul Ḥijjah; the day of ‘Āshūrā’ and three days of each month...” (Nasā’ī).

Dhul Hijjah: To Do List

1-8th

- Lots of Dhikr, especially tahlil, takbir and tahmid
- Takbir in the homes, markets and streets.
- Fast as many days as possible.

9th (Day of Arafah)

- Keep a fast.
- Takbir of Tashriq once after each fard salah
- Lots of Dhikr and repeat frequently:
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ
- Du'a, especially for freedom from Hell.

10th (Day of Eid)

- Eid salah & the sunnahs of Eid.
- Perform qurbani and share it with others.
- Spread joy 😊
- Takbir of Tashriq after each fard salah.
- Lots of Dhikr!

11-13th (Days of Tashriq)

- Eat, drink and lots of Dhikr!
- Takbir of Tashriq until after 'Asr of the 13th.

“

Ibn Hajar  said the reason that these 10 days are so special is because all of the major acts of worship occur in them, which doesn't happen in other days: ṣalāh, fasting, charity and ḥajj. Although it is possible to combine the first three deeds on an ordinary day, the great worship of ḥajj is restricted to these blessed days.

”

"There are no days on which righteous deeds are more beloved to Allah than these 10 days (the first 10 of Dhul Hijjah)." (Tirmidhi)

"There are no days greater in the sight of Allah or in which good deeds are more beloved to Him than these 10 days. So recite a great deal of tahlil (lā ilāha illā-Allāh), takbir (Allāhu Akbar) and taḥmīd (Alḥamdu li-llāh)." (Aḥmad)

Allāhu akbar Allāhu akbar Allāhu akbar, lā ilāha illā-Allāh, wa-līlāhu akbar Allāhu akbar, wa līl-lāhī-l-ḥamd.

Recite the takbirāt of tashrīq audibly after each fard ṣalāh, starting from the Fajr of the 9th of Dhul Hijjah till the 'Asr of 13th Dhul Hijjah (subject to local moonsighting).
