- 1. Zayd has been wanting to get married for a long time and is struggling.
- 2. Khalid feels that Allah has blessed with him everything: imān, inspirational friends, a spacious house, an amazing family and good health.
- 3. Abdullah got up to a lot of things in his youth which he'd rather forget. The guilt is always gnawing away at him and he keeps feeling like he is still suffering from the consequences of his sins.
- 4. Khadijah has upcoming GCSE exams and wants to do well in them.
- 5. Layth suffers from anxiety.
- 6. Hasan is a student of knowledge and wants Allah to make this path easy for him.
- 7. Aishah feels like life is a constant battle and if it's not one thing, then it's the other. She feels trapped and is contemplating ending her life.
- 8. Luqman lives in a non-Muslim country and is surrounded by fitan. He worries about his imān and the imān of his children.
- 9. Sarah suffers from a chronic illness and is frequently in a lot of pain.
- 10. Ahmad and Fatimah who are struggling to conceive.
- 11. Hanan's no.1 fear is public speaking and is terrified of an upcoming presentation she has to deliver in front of her entire school.
- 12. Hajar and Abdul-Hayy have 5 children mashallah. Whilst the sleepless nights and endless nappies were difficult, raising them on imān and taqwā in their teens feels even more difficult.
