
The Human Being





The Verdict

- Verses 24-26 reason for revelation: Walīd b. Mughīrah.
- Strong verse; direct command.
- كَفًار: noun of intensity of kāfir. Allah gave them chance upon chance, but they were extremely **stubborn** and denied the truth.
